◆ **A 4-H Member:** Login in to your 4-H Family Account on 4-H Online. Scroll down to 'Register a Member for an Event', select members name and select the event you are registering for—continue following the instructions.

**You will get an email approving your event registration. About a week before the training, you will receive a mailing with required release forms that will need to be completed and handed in at the first class in order for your child to participate in the classes.**
