What can I bring to the city burn pile?

TREE BRANCHES ONLY

according to The North Dakota state Health Dept.

NOT allowed

- Mattresses (metal springs & toxic fumes from the materials contained in the mattress)
- Sofas and stuffed chairs—same reasons
- Tires, shingles, or anything with rubber or tar (more toxic smoke and fumes)
- Construction lumber, doors, windows, No plastics, glass, aluminum, or garbage please
- Any amount of metal connected to something burnable.

The burn pile is located at the end of 1st street.

If the weather has been rainy the burn pile may not be available.

Please do not dump branches in front of the burn pile or throw them over the fence. The city will make every effort to accommodate a time that works for you.

The burn pile is a very convenient place to take tree branches. It can and will be shut down by the State Health Dept. if we don't use it properly. **Help us monitor it by calling the city office if you notice anyone unloading unauthorized items or get a license plate number & description of the vehicle so it can be reported & removed before burning.** (There is also camera to see activity).

Also: The compost dumpsters by the burn pile are for LEAVES & GRASS only!!

Please, no trees, branches, or garbage.
