 - b. 1 ¾" Hose
 - i. Replacement hose has been ordered with Grand Forks Fire.
 - ii. Undamaged hose previously ordered will be returned.
 - c. Fog Nozzle
 - i. Parts are in for the repair of the crosslay fog nozzle.
 - d. Hose/Appliance/Pump Testing
 - i. Pump test will be scheduled after new 1 ¾" hose arrives.
 - ii. Tests will be scheduled for a Saturday and will ask another department to utilize their hose tester.
